The Vöcklabruck experience begins in the town centre. The picturesque and lively town centre is the starting point for a journey of discovery into the history of the town on the river Vöckla – from Roman times through to the present day.

TOWN SQUARE

1 From time immemorial, the town square has served as a meeting place. Numerous markets and restaurants all help to create a lively environment where it is a pleasure to go for a stroll or do a bit of shopping. The town centre is framed by rows of houses which date from late Medieval times, all of which are well worth seeing. Their façades go back as far as the Baroque period and also have their roots in classicism.

TOWN TOWERS

2 The upper and lower town towers don't just border the historical centre of Vöcklabruck. They are also interesting artistic and historic-cultural monuments in their own right. These include the unique and intact heralds of the Habsburg Emperor, Maximilian I. During renovation work in 1958 and 1966, frescos by the Tyrolean Court master builder, Jörg Kolderer were discovered. The lower town tower features a black, two-headed imperial eagle, the crests of Austrian hereditary lands and of Burgund, and an effigy of the Emperor. In the upper town tower two knights are depicted riding into town, as are a crowned imperial coats of arms borne by two lions and the coat of arms of the Austrian provinces.



MARIA SCHÖNDORF CHURCH

3 Perched majestically on a hill in the oldest part of town and enjoying a prime position, this church served as the parish church of Vöcklabruck until 1785. The two unmatched towers are characteristic of this building, which was first mentioned in historic records in 824. In addition to the most precious object in the church of Maria Schöndorf, namely the „Beautiful Madonna“ – a statue of Maria created around 1430 by an unknown artist, the newly designed cemetery is also worth visiting.

TOWN PARISH CHURCH OF ST. ULRICH

4 If you turn left before the Upper town tower when coming from the town square, you will arrive at the church of St. Ulrich downtown after about 1000 meters. This two-bay hall church, which is typical of the late Gothic period in Upper-Austria, has a choir with reticulated and cross-ribbed vaulting and a nave. The Baroque altars and the pulpit are of red marble and date back to the 18th Century.

CULTURAL HISTORY, LIVE

Vöcklabruck's rich past is mirrored by the variety of different churches in the town. The majestic church of Maria Schöndorf leads the way, with its new cemetery buildings and organ.

SIGHTS LANDMARKS

from the past

DÖRFL CHURCH ST. ÄGYDI

5 The Dörfel church, as it is fondly called in Vöcklabruck, was formally Upper-Austria's first hospital and was built by Pilgrim v. Weng in the 12th Century. Originally constructed as a hospice, it is thought to be the third oldest of its kind to have been managed by a brotherhood and to have acquired significance. Since the renovation work which took place in 1980, the interior of the church has shone with its former Baroque brilliance.

PROTESTANT CHURCH OF PEACE

6 This church was one of the first Protestant sacred buildings to be constructed after the Protestant faith was recognised in Upper-Austria in the 19th Century. Designed by Viennese architect, Hermann Wehrenpfenning, it was built in the years 1871 to 1875. Since 1981, the Protestant Church of Peace has been the proud owner of a new organ with 22 organ stops.

MUSEUM OF LOCAL HISTORY

7 The museum of local history in downtown Vöcklabruck is home to an extensive collection of prehistoric and folkloristic items from the region. The museum is housed in a town house constructed around 1500 and features buildings on stilts from Lake Attersee and a cross-section of agricultural and bourgeois life from Vöcklabruck's past. The first floor is devoted to Anton Bruckner – and a separate memorial room to his biographer, Max Auer.

OLD TOWN WALL MUSEUM AND BLACK SMITH'S MUSEUM

8 In the Müller family's cellar in the Parkstraße, you can experience history at first hand. For the cellar is home to the largest intact part of the original town wall of Vöcklabruck. Moreover, this small, private museum features a showroom with an old blacksmith's works.

TOWN TOWER AND TOUR OF TOWN WALL

The two town towers are among the most important landmarks of Vöcklabruck. The lower town tower (35m high) is open to visitors. It is worth climbing to the viewing platform which provides you with an excellent view of Vöcklabruck and the surrounding area. Twelve themed panels invite you to walk along the former old town wall.

FLOWER MARKET: Vöcklabruck in full bloom – with organic gardener Karl Ploberger, in April

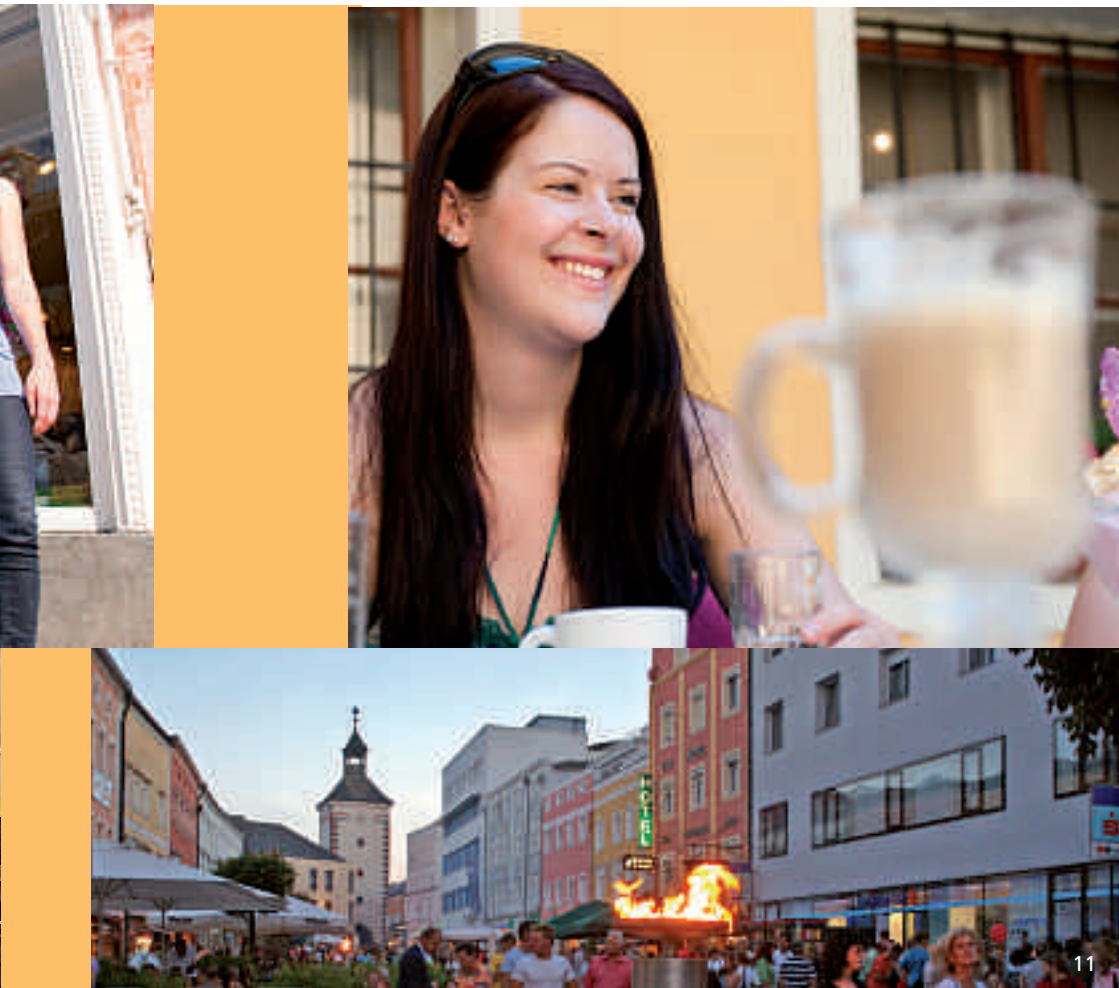

In its capacity as the district capital, Vöcklabruck offers a wide-ranging and exciting programme of cultural events. From a New Year's Eve concert in the town hall to an open-air cinema, from an evening of cabaret to matinee performances and from wine festivals to carol singing.

TOWN HALL

12 Around 150 events are held every year in the town hall which is located in the town square in Vöcklabruck. The hall holds up to 760 people and is seen as a centre for cultural events. The programme ranges from advent events for children to concerts for OAPs, from new Austrian folk music to Chamber music, and from classical acting to cabarets. Whether you are theatre buffs or music fans, you're bound to find something to your taste.

13 The Vöckla library is located in the parish centre of Vöcklabruck. Along with the „reading room“ which belongs to it, it offers ample opportunity to browse and read. 

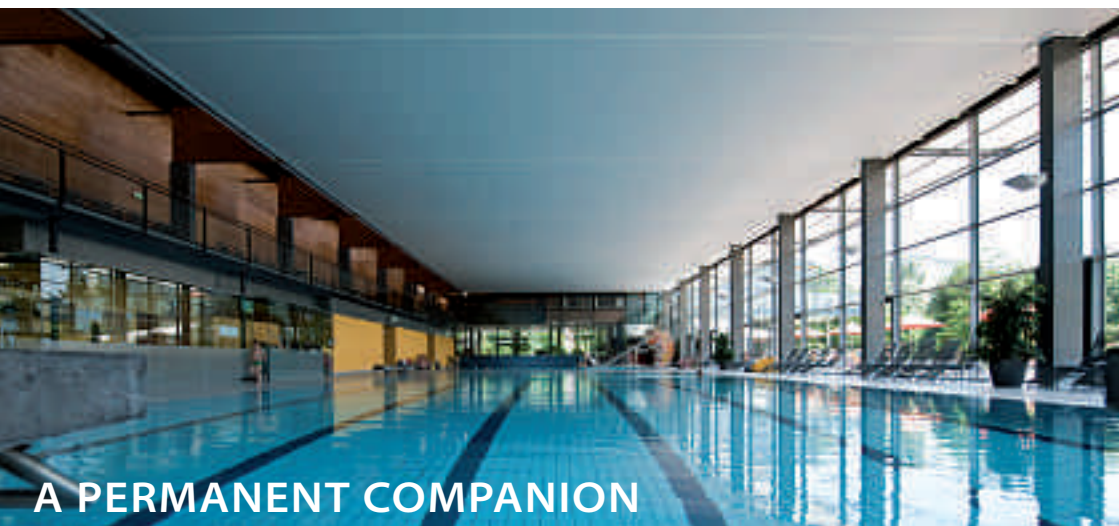
ANTON-BRUCKNER CIRCULAR ROUTE

15 You can retrace the footsteps of the great composer on a cultural tour through Vöcklabruck. For almost 40 years, Anton Bruckner spent a part of his holidays each year in Vöcklabruck visiting his sister, Sali. He was an honorary member of the Singing Society, celebrated his 60th birthday here, and this is where he finished the first movement of his 8th symphony. The 9 stop-offs along this walking route tell interesting stories about the life of this famous Upper-Austrian.

WALKING ROUTES IN AND AROUND VÖCKLABRUCK

16 You can walk, hike or run on the 12 routes which are marked out. One popular scenic outpost in Vöcklabruck is the „Hamisches Gatterl“, cultural monument. Other routes lead to Altwartenburg, along the Vöckla and Ager rivers, through the forest or in the forest of Sonnleiten. A plan is available from the Tourist Office which provides you with an overview of all of the routes.

17 From action to relaxation, there is always something going on here. The swimming pool, sauna and outdoor pool are all located in the town park. Newly renovated, they offer even greater fun in the water for young and old alike: adventure pool, water slide, kids' pool, beach volleyball court and 6,500 m² of public green space. In the swimming pool, you can swim and splash as much as you wish all year round. In the sauna on the first floor of the swimming pool building, you will find seven saunas (two of which are located outdoors), a plunge pool, a

TOWN OF SPAS AND EMPERORS | BAD ISCHL

Bad Ischl is a charming town and the cultural centre of the Salzkammergut. The imperial town is also a spa centre – steeped in tradition, yet with a feel for the spirit of the times. To this day, the town still retains many of the features that gave it its reputation as an imperial town. At every turn, the visitor encounters reminders of the past when history was written in Bad Ischl. The Emperor's villa is well worth a visit.

Thanks to the operetta of the same name by Ralph Benatzky, the “White Horse Inn at Lake St. Wolfgang” is well known beyond the borders of Austria. The hotel-restaurant lies directly on the lake at the heart of the picturesque town of St. Wolfgang. On the Schafberg railway, the steepest cogwheel railway in Austria, one can climb the Schafberg, which is 1,780 meters high and one of the most beautiful mountains, offering a panoramic view of the Salzkammergut.

A trip to Lake Attersee is worthwhile! The lake, which is 21 km long and 3km wide, is ideal for bathing and the water is of drinking quality. It is one of the most beautiful lakes in Austria and is most easily discovered by boat. You can find the schedule for the Attersee boat trips on the internet or in the Tourist Office. Anyone wishing to enjoy the lake from above would be well advised to undertake a hiking tour to the Hochlecken or the Schoberstein.
